**Hollywood stars to present plans for
12,000 sq. ft. “Peace Palace” in Los Angeles**

**John Hagelin to announce formation
of new U.S. Peace Government**

Terrorist alerts. Violent crime. Budget crises. Los Angeles is in the grip of an epidemic of traumatic stress. Now, a group of Hollywood stars and business leaders will announce their plan to build a Peace Palace dedicated entirely to bringing relief to the stressed population of the city and promoting peace for a turbulent world.

John Hagelin, Ph.D. The 12,000 square foot Peace Palace will be one of 100 in the United States and 3,000 worldwide. Already three \$4 million Peace Palaces have opened in Bethesda, Maryland; Lexington, Kentucky; and Fairfield, Iowa.

Director David Lynch; actresses Heather Graham, Laura Dern, and Laura Harring; and actor Stephen Collins will be among the stars and business leaders who will host a news conference on Thursday, June 12, 10:30 a.m., at the Four Seasons Hotel, Burton Room, 300 South Doheny Drive, in Beverly Hills.

In addition, Dr. John Hagelin, quantum physicist and presidential candidate of the Natural Law Party in 2000, will announce the formation of a new non-profit organization to administer the Peace Palaces and offer public-outreach programs to prevent crime and violence and other problems in all areas of society. The new “U.S. Peace Government,” to be launched in Washington, D.C. on July 2, will promote coherence and harmony in the nation.
